First draft is edited by Editor or Editor in Chief and sent to reviewers* for comments and corrections

New draft is prepared by a Medical Letter editor together with the Editor or Editor in Chief, taking into account reviewers' possible conflicts of interest

Complete editorial review for:

Accuracy

Completeness

Scientific Rigor

Objectivity

Further revisions by editors, Editor and Editor in Chief

Review by Editor in Chief

Final revisions

The final article is printed and mailed to subscribers
